

# PROTEST FOR THE RELEASE OF POLITICAL PRISONERS OF Jan 6th

*Holding Prisoners with no due process is totalitarian!*

**[SEATTLE, WA Sept 18, 2001]** — The Anti-Chinese Communist Party groups, and Chinese Democracy & Human Rights Alliance (CDHRA), will be holding a protest in conjunction with the national protest by Look Ahead America, in front of the Seattle Department of Justice office (700 Stewart St # 5220, Seattle, WA 98101) on September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at 2 PM.

The CDHRA wants to bring attention to the plight of the American citizens who are being denied due process and being held for attending the January 6<sup>th</sup> event in Washington DC. Being tried in the court of public opinion with the media as the judge, jury, and executioner is NOT due process.

“Like the Chinese Communist Party (CCP), Communist regimes will create stories or reasons to make your life miserable - they will make sure you have no money and no job, so that you never dare to speak or act against Communist dictatorships.” Said Jane Jin, leader of the group. She went on to say, “Chinese exiles, those who escaped from the CCP regime, just like Russia, Vietnam, Cambodia, all know what Communism and Socialism will do to us!”

The Department of Justice is holding many political prisoners due to the Jan 6th entrance into the Capitol building. Many have been held since Jan. 6th without being charged or the opportunity to see a judge, and some are being mistreated, being held in solitary confinement, right out of the CCP playbook. In comparison, the rioters of Antifa and BLM have gotten away with the murder of 25 people and got released on bail.

We demand the US government immediately release these American Citizens who were arrested on Jan. 6th, 2021, on Capitol Hill while expressing their opinions and peaceably assembling, which are their Constitutionally protected rights.
